2009 ANNUAL REPORT

Friday, January 29, 2010
4:00 P.M.

Deadline for filing the **ANNUAL** Campaign Finance Report. (Does **not** need to be filed if a Post-General 2009 was filed) Report to include contributions and expenditures thru December 31, 2010.

FEBRUARY SPECIAL

Thursday, January 21, 2010
4:00 P.M.

ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2010

Deadline for filing **Pre-Special** finance report (close end of business day, Wednesday, January 13, the 20th day before the election) due 12 days before the election.

Friday, March 12, 2010
4:00 P.M.

Deadline for filing **Post-Special** finance report (from close of Pre-Election report to the 7th day before the report is due, March 5th, 2010) due 38 days after the election.

MAY PRIMARY/SPECIAL

Thursday, April 22, 2010
4:00 P.M.

ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2010 (PRIMARY/SPECIAL)

Deadline for filing **Pre-Primary/Special** finance report (close end of business day, Wednesday, April 14th, the 20th day before the election), due 12 days before the election.

Friday, June 11, 2010
4:00 P.M.

Deadline for filing **Post-Primary/Special** finance report (from close of Pre-election report to the 7th day before the report is due, June 4, 2010) due 38 days after the election.

SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT

Friday, July 30, 2010
4:00 P.M.

MID-YEAR REPORT

Deadline for the **Mid-Year** finance report for all entities **except** for those who file Post-Primary reports and judicial candidates. When a Post-Primary was not filed (non-election year), the campaign committee of a state-wide candidate or candidate for county office must file. The Semi-Annual report of any other candidate committee is due only if the campaign committee has total contributions in excess of \$10,000 since last report filed. PAC's, PCE's and Ballot Issue committees are required to file a semi-annual unless a report was filed after the immediately preceding primary election. Close books end of business day, Tuesday, June 30th.

AUGUST SPECIAL

Thursday, July 22, 2010
4:00 P.M.

ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, AUGUST 3, 2010

Deadline for filing **Pre-Special** finance report, (close end of business day, Wednesday, July 14th, the 20th day before the election), due 12 days before the election.

Friday, September 10, 2010
4:00 P.M.

Deadline for filing **Post-Special** finance report (from close of Pre-election report to the 7th day before the report is due, September 3, 2010) due 38 days after the election.

2010 CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORT FILING DEADLINES

NOVEMBER GENERAL

Thursday, October 21, 2010
4:00 P.M.

ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2010

Deadline for filing **Pre-General** finance report, (close end of Business day, Wednesday, October 13th, the 20th day before the election) due 12 days before the election.

Friday, December 10, 2010
4:00 P.M.

Deadline for filing **Post-General** finance report (from close of Pre-election report to the 7th day before the report is due, December 3, 2010), due 38 days after the election.

Candidates unsuccessful in the Primary Election with an open committee are required to file a 2010 Annual report.

ANNUAL 2010 FINANCE REPORT The 2010 **Annual** finance report is due by 4:00 P.M., Monday, January 31, 2011.

Top Ten Important Helpful Hints when Preparing a Campaign Finance Report

1. File a Designation of Treasurer (Form 30-D), before receiving contributions or spending campaign funds or the candidates own funds.
2. Check your math (no rounding).
3. If this is not your first report, start where you left off. (Line 6 of your previous report is now line 1 of your current report.
4. **Do not** use pencil.
5. **Do not** include copies of **contribution checks** or copies of cash with your report. Keep them for your records only.
6. For every expense over \$25.00, **you must include** a copy of a cancelled check, a bank statement for all electronic transactions or a PAID (zero balance) receipt. Please **do not** include copies of invoices that show a balance due.
7. Use the proper forms for your transactions. All forms and instructions can be downloaded from the Secretary of State's website. Be sure to fill out all items on the report pages.
8. If you take any contributions, **you must** open up a separate checking account. You cannot mix campaign funds with personal funds. The committee will be automatically referred to the Ohio Elections Commission if funds are co-mingled.
9. The committee **cannot accept** more than \$100.00 in cash from a single contributor. This is currency and coins.
10. All reports **must be received, not postmarked**, by 4:00 on their due date. **Do not fax**. Please refer to the above dates. If a report is received late, it is an automatic referral to the Ohio Elections Commission.

Who will file Ethics Disclosure forms in 2010?

1. All elected state, county, city officials and judges by April 15, 2010. File at appropriate office (on form).
2. All candidates for state, county, city offices, judges and all candidates for Akron school board need to file 30 days prior to appearing on the ballot. File at appropriate office (on form).
