ISSUE #

- 1** **COPLEY-FAIRLAWN CSD** - An additional tax for the benefit of Copley-Fairlawn School District for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 6.90 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 69 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

- 2** **NORTON CSD** - Proposed Bond Issue in the principal amount of \$27,505,239 to average 4.6 mills, maximum repayment period of 37 years, for constructing, furnishing, equipping, adding to, renovating, remodeling, rehabilitating, and improving School District buildings and facilities and acquiring, clearing, improving and equipping real estate for school purposes
Proposed Tax Levy – (Additional) at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for financing of general permanent improvements, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

- 3** **HIGHLAND LSD** – Shall a levy be imposed by the Highland Local School District for the purpose of PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT in the sum of three million eight hundred thirteen thousand eight hundred dollars (\$3,813,800) and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average five and nine-tenths (5.9) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty-nine cents (\$0.59) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011?
