Allocation of M-100's, AutoMARKS, and booths for the September 8, 2015 Primary Election

Requirement of Public Meeting – R.C. 3501.11 (I) and Directive 2008-64 requires that each board of elections conduct a full vote of the board during public session on the allocation and distribution of voting machines, tabulating equipment and marking devices for each precinct prior to each election day.

The total number of M100s (precinct count optical scanners) for distribution on election day is 300 (242 - 1 M100 for each precinct and 58 extra). Extra M100s will be charged, kept at the Board of Elections, and available for backup deployment.

The total number of AutoMARKS for election day is 145 (111 - 1 per polling location, 4 polling locations that vote in multiple rooms and require 2 AutoMARKS and 28 extra) Extra AutoMARKS will be charged, kept at the Board of Elections, and available for backup deployment.

The total number of 650's (high speed optical scanners) is 6. They will remain at the Board of Elections.

The number of booths for each precinct is 1 per each 100 registered voters, with 4 being the minimum.

The Summit County Board of Elections follows the Secretary of State's guidelines and Ohio Revised Code for allocating voting equipment for each election as described in Directive 2008-64 and O.R.C. 3506.19.
